# Scholarship table "UM, Mi Mejor Opción"

We reward your preference. If you apply to the first option in Temuco and you have a NEM according to the table —and you are selected—you will be awarded discounts of upto 100% of the 2015 enrollment fee. Apply for the 2013 and 2014 PSU and for special admission if you have applied via the Single Application System of the Council of Rectors of Chilean Universities.

# Familia Mayor scholarship (Enrollment Fee subsidy)

If a sibling, spouse, mother, father or child studies at Universidad Mayor, the family is benefited by onlypaying one enrollment fee, corresponding to the highest amount. This also applies to special admission students.

## **PSU** score scholarship

It provides 20% to 100% discounts according to the PSU (2013-2014) score section by major and branch, whichis valid for the entire major and with renewal requirements. If you do not comply with the requirements, you can opt for the Honor Roll Scholarships for Higher Courses.

It benefits all first year students entering in 2015 with an avergage 2013 or 2014 PSU score equal to or higer than 620 points.

# It provides:

- the possibility to do a semester in one of the universities which are part of the international U. Mayor agreement, including a free return airfare ticketto the exchange country.
- -no additional tuition payment for students at the selected university.
- free English b-learning courses, at no extra cost, which will take them to an ALTE4 level.

#### Important:

This beneft is compatible with both the 2015 Enrollment and Tuition Scholarships.

## **Teaching scholarship**

It is a combination of benefits that seeks to strengthen the cultural and professional of future educators. It is awarded to students that enter via regular or special admission to one of the Faculty of Education majors leading to a teaching degree.

## The benefits are:

- the possibility to do a semester in one of the universities which are part of the international U. Mayor agreement, including a free return airfare ticket to the exchange country.
- -no additional tuition payment at the selected university.
- -free English b-learning courses till level ALTE4.
- -free Masters Program at Universidad Mayor's College of Education (valid aftergraduation according to the current offer).

## Important:

This benefit is compatible with "Vocación de Profesor" State Scholarship, in accordance with free tuition and enrollment for regular students with a PSU average score of 600 or more (referential 2014 \*).

#### Araucanía scholarship (Exclusively at Temuco campus)

It benefits students from Temuco branch, in Physical Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Nutrition and Dietetics, Psychology, Dentistry, Speech-Language Pathology, Veterinary Medicine, Civil Engineering and Industrial Engineering majors.

It is given to degree candidates from educational institutions of Región de la Araucanía, giving the benefit of 20% of discount of the annual tuition, according to program of study. Benefits with renovation requirements.

If you do not accomplish the renovation requirements, you can opt to Cuadro de Honor scholarship for higher studies.

# National Score scholarship (Beca de Arancel for first year)

Benefit for students who reach PSU 2013 or 2014 National Score in one of the following 4 tests: Languaje, Mathematics, Sciences or History and Social sciences.

It gives 100% of discount in the first year tuition of Universidad Mayor major.

# Important:

Benefit compatible with Enrollment scholarships, U.Mayor Pedagogy scholarship and "Beneficio Red Internacional Mayor" scholarship. Incompatible with other Annual Free Tuition 2015 scholarships.

# **Universidad Mayor Scholarships – For Higher Courses(referential 2015)**

#### **Award for Academic Performance**

It is awarded annually to students with the highest grade average of the major who has not failed or used internal credit transfers the previous year. It consists of releasing students of payments during the year they receive the award.

### **Honor Roll scholarship**

Encourages academic merit by granting a 15% of major annual tuition scholarship for the year the students is enrolled.

It is benefits, as of second year major, to all regular Universidad Mayor students who accomplish the following requirements:

Have entered the institution at least in 2012 onwards.

Belong to the 10% best students of their cohorte/major.

Have not failed the academic load from the preceding year (or 2 semesters).

# **External Scholarships**

## "President of the Republic" scholarship

The Chilean State through JUNAEB, provides monthly cash assistance freely to regular students taking first year in Higher Education, who have a good academic performance and limited economic resources.

## Indigenous scholarship

It is awarded by JUNAEB to students of indigenous descendant, who meet special socioeconomic conditions.

#### "Juan Gómez Millas" scholarship

Tuition Scholarship awarded to students of merit who have left public or private subsidized secondary schools and who are enrolled in Higher Education (D.F.L. N°4 de 1981) or in Private Higher Education Institutions that have reached complete autonomy.

# "Juan Gómez Millas" scholarship for foreign students

It is aimed at foreign students that are permanent residents in Chilewho are from Latin America or the Carribeans, that are in the social vulnerability category, and that choose to study at a higher education institution that is accredited by the National Accreditation Commission.

## **Academic Excellence scholarship**

It is directed at the best 10% high school students who have studied at a public school (Municipalizada), semi-private (particulares Subvencionada) or Technical/Professional Establishments.

## "Children of Educational professionals" scholarship

It is aimed at commendablestudents that have studied at a publicschooland that enroll in a higher education institution (D.F.L. N°4 of 1981) orin a private higher education institution that have reached full autonomy.

## **PSU score scholarship (BPSU)**

This Tuition Scholarship is aimed at high school students entering university who have studied at a public school, semi-private orTechnical/Professional Establishments, and that obtained a national or regional score in the PSU for the 2014 admission process.

## Reparations scholarship

## "Vocación de Profesor" scholarship

It is directed at students who enroll for the first time as first year students in teaching majors that have been accredited by the National Accreditation Commissionby 31<sup>st</sup> December 2014, as well as the institution.

Benefits:

If the PSU score is:

Higher than or equal to 720 points, finances: tuition scholarship + enrollment fee + a contribution of \$80.000 on a monthly basis + a semester abroad.

Higher than or equal to 700 points, finances: tuition scholarship + enrollment fee + a contribution of \$80.000 on a monthly basis.

Higher than or equal to 600 points, finances: tuition scholarship + enrollment fee.

#### Requirements for students:

- Chilean nationality
- -Obtain at leastan average of 600 points in the PSU (Languaje and Mathematics) in the 2013 or 2014 admission process (PSU 2012-2013) with which the students were selected to enter the major; or at least 580 points for 2013 students who are part of the best 10% of public, semi-public or Technical/Professional Establishments(BEA scholarship).
- Apply by completing the form available at www.becavocaciondeprofesor.cl
- -Not having previously received in more than one ocassion a tuition benefit from MINEDUC as a first year student.
- -Not having studied a major that was eligible for this scholarship in previous years (without considering if s/he obtained this benefit)
- Enroll during 2015 in an eligible major for this scholarship.

It considers the regular teaching majors. The Distance, Special Capstone or other special course Programs that the institution carries out are not considered as eligible.

# Scholarships per Agreement (Referential 2015)

## "Ilustre Municipalidad de Santiago" scholarship of academic excellence

Universidad Mayor awards a scholarship to students attending a school in the county of Santiago, and to the children of professionals who work in education at the Office of Education of the Municipality of Santiago, indepedently of the county where they attend school. These scholarships are for the majors given in the College of Education of Universidad Mayor. The discount cannot be combined with another discount or scholarship, whether it be an UM benefit or from another institution. The scholarships and benefits will only come into effect when the student enrolls and presents the respective institutional certificate of enrollment. The interested party should find out about the bases and requirements of each scholarship and hand in the corresponding documentation (a certificate attesting the right to benefit; credentials will not be accepted)

## "CEPECH" scholarship

Universidad Mayor will give a 10% discount on the annual tuition fee (it excludes the enrollment fee and fees corresponding to the capstone experience) to degree candidates and/or graduates of Auditing and Business Administration (Associate's Degree)from the Cepech Institute, who may continue their studies in the UM Business Management major. The discount cannot be combined with other discounts or scholarships the student could apply for, whether it be an UM benefit or from another institution.

The scholarships and benefits only become effective at the moment of registration and submitting the appropriate certificate of membership of the institution. The interested partyshould find out about the bases and requirements of each scholarship agreement and bring the required documents (a certificate attesting the right to benefit; credentials are not accepted).

# "Carabineros de Chile" scholarship

Universidad Mayor will grant a 10% discount of the annual tuition fee (it excludes the enrollment fee and fees corresponding to the capstone experience) to staff of Carabineros of Chile, to their spouses and children in all the majors offered by Universidad Mayor, except for the majors in the College of Medicine and Dentistry.

The discount cannot be combined with other discounts or scholarships the student could apply for, whether it be an UM benefit or from another institution.

The scholarships and benefits only become effective at the moment of registration and submitting the appropriate certificate of membership of the institution. The interested partyshould find out about the bases and requirements of each scholarship agreement and bring the required documents (a certificate attesting the right to benefit; credentials are not accepted).

# "Ejército de Chile" scholarship

Universidad Mayor will grant a 10% discount of the annual tuition fee (it excludes the enrollment fee and fees corresponding to the capstone experience) to Army personnel, their spouses, children and dependents, in all the majors offered by Universidad Mayor, except for the majors in the College of Medicine and Dentistry.

The discount cannot be combined with other discounts or scholarships the student could apply for, whether it be an UM benefit or from another institution.

## "CFT Magnos" scholarship

Universidad Mayor will grant a 25% discount of the annual tuition fee (it excludes the enrollment fee and fees corresponding to the capstone experience) degree candidates or graduates from "Formación Técnica Magnos".

You may apply by appealing to the benefit off all the day time or evening majors and to the graduate programs, and diploma courses offered by Universidad Mayor, except for the majors and programs of the Schools of Medicine, Physical Therapy, Dentistry, and the majors offered by the Conservatory of Music at Universidad Mayor.

The beneficiaries of this agreement shall comply with all the application requirements and promotion established by the University. The discount cannot be combined with other discounts or scholarships the student could apply for, whether it be an UM benefit or from another institution.

The scholarships and benefits will become effective only if the applicant is selected for the major or program of preference (except for Medicine, Dentistry, Physical Therapy and the Conservatory of Music). In this case, the selected applicant must prove to be a degree candidate or graduate from Magnos by presenting a certificate of enrollment.

# Loans (Referential 2015)

### **Universidad Mayor Loan**

Students who for reasons beyond their control may be affected to continue their studies at Universidad Mayor can access, following a report from a social worker, to a loan to cover up to 50% of their tuition fee.

## State-sponsored Loan for accredited universities

#### WHAT IS THE STATE-SPONSORED LOAN?

It is a benefit of the State given to students of high academic standards that need financial support to start or continue a major in one of the colleges that make up the State Sponsored Loan System (List at <a href="www.ingresa.cl">www.ingresa.cl</a>)

#### WHAT IS IT?

It is a financial credit system, which is guaranteed by the institution of higher education in which the student is studying, and by the state, which will be the student's guarantee until the student has paid the credit in full, after graduating.

## **HOW IS IT PAID?**

It is paid over 20 years. The student is not required to pay anything while studying and up to 18 months after graduation. In addition, the payment can be put on hold for up to one year in the event of unemployment or if the fee exceeds half of the student/cosigner's income.

#### REQUIREMENTS

- 1. Be Chilean or a foreigner with permanent residence in the country.
- 2. Socio-economic conditions of the family group that justify the granting of the benefit.
- 3. Be enrolled in an undergraduate program at an autonomous institution of higher education, accredited and that takes part in the State Sponsored Loan System.

The list of the Council of Rectors of Chilean Universities, private universities, professional institutes, technical training centers and military schools of the Armed Forces, which meet these requirements can be found at <a href="https://www.ingresa.cl">www.ingresa.cl</a>

Not having completed a college-level major with funding from the University Credit Solidarity Fund and/or this credit. Academic merit requested by Universidad Mayor.

For a freshman: Average PSU score 2010 (Language and Mathematics) of 500 points. For senior students: they must have completed 70% of the total credit or of the courses registered in the last two academic semesters.

## **HOW TO APPLY?**

Only via the Internet by completingthe Socio-economic Accreditation Form (FUAS) available at <a href="https://www.becasycreditos.cl">www.becasycreditos.cl</a>, once the application process has begun.

## HOW IS THIS LOAN ALLOCATED?

The State delivers this in a strict socio-economic order, starting with those applicants in greatest need of funding. The list of preselected students is published in December at <a href="https://www.ingresa.cl">www.ingresa.cl</a>

With the preassigned credit, the student must give effect to the benefit by enrolling in one of the higher education institutions of the system (list available at <a href="https://www.ingresa.cl">www.ingresa.cl</a>).

Once assigned, the benefit extends throughout the major without the need to reapply. However, each year, upon enrollment, students must undertake the process of renewal of the credit at the institution where the student studies.
